

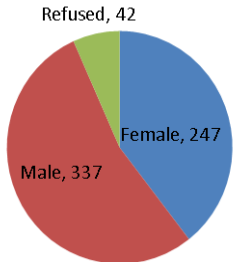
# 2015 HELENA POINT IN TIME SURVEY

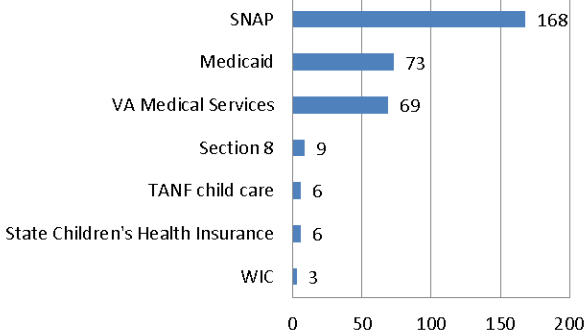

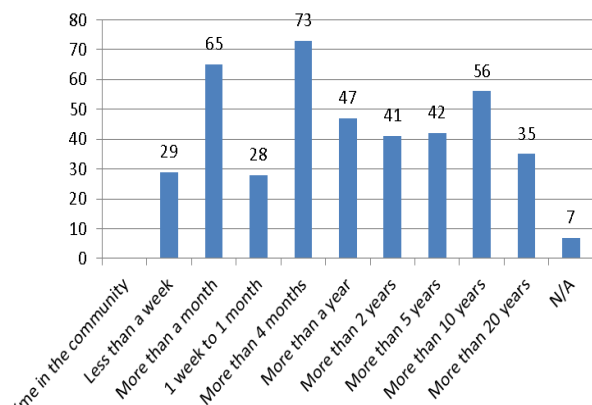
## Non-Cash Benefits Received

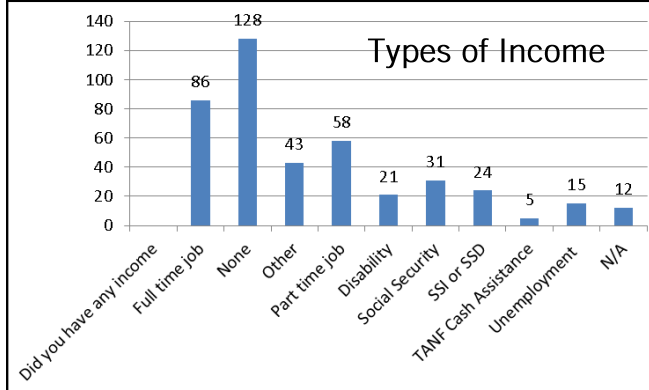
## Time in the Community

**69%** OF RESPONDENTS HAVE SOME SORT OF INCOME.

**20%** OF RESPONDENTS INDICATED A SUBSTANCE ABUSE PROBLEM. 6% OF RESPONDENTS INDICATED MENTAL HEALTH PROBLEMS.

5% INDICATED CHRONIC HEALTH PROBLEMS, AND 4% INDICATED A PHYSICAL DISABILITY, PREVENTED THEM FROM HOLDING A JOB OR LIVING IN STABLE HOUSING.
